- 2.1 To register with the mailing list on this Website, some of your particulars are required for the purposes of SCE providing registrants with news and updates on SCE. SCE reserves the right to determine the contents thereof and disseminate them via e-mail (or any other forms of communication media) to the registrants.
- 2.2 SCE reserves the right to suspend and/or terminate (either in whole or in part) mailing updates to any registrant of its mailing list on this Website immediately, for any reason whatsoever, without prior notice.

3. Project Proposals and Job Resume Submissions

- 3.1 For more detailed submissions, such as leads, project proposals or job resumes, these will include requisite information for SCE to evaluate your offerings and provisions on a preliminary basis.
